What does our club have to offer?

Pet Dog Manners (PDM)

You may already have completed this course and are now ready for other training experiences the club has to offer. Or, this may be a new option for you. You do not have to be a member of the club to enrol in this course. See enrolments@wdta.org.nz.

Canine Good Citizen (CGC)

CGC is a national assessed curriculum that covers food manners, accepting friendly strangers, walking in a controlled manner, appearance and grooming and control around other dogs. There are four levels of achievement – Foundation, Bronze, Silver and Gold. Our club is a CGC registered club and we have a local Assessor. Rally Obedience (Rally O)

Rally-O is a great dog sport that can be enjoyed by dogs (and people!) of any age and ability. The dog and their handler are required to perform a different exercise every few metres. Agility

We offer training from pre-agility to competition level. This involves jumps, tunnels, weaves and raised contact equipment. Dogs must be over 12 months old. Flygility

Flygility is a dog sport that mixes elements of agility and flyball. In flygility the dog is sent over a series of obstacles to retrieve a ball they must trigger and catch from a flyball box, then return over the same course in reverse.
